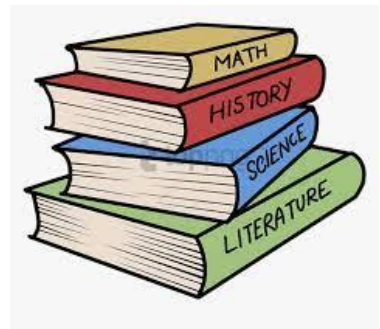
Ellesmere Port
