<u>Action for Brain Injury Week, 20th-26th May 2024 – Theme: A Life</u> <u>Rewritten</u>

This will focus on experiences of life before and after a brain injury and how this changes our individual identity and life stories. It is also about the many different ripple effects this creates for those around us and our experiences in the wider world.

Headway identifies that in the UK, someone is admitted to hospital with a brain injury every 90 seconds. This is much more common than people realise and has been referred to as a hidden epidemic. These figures are from hospital admission data and present an astonishing picture of how suddenly someone's life and that of those around them can completely change forever.

The theme of "A Life Rewritten" for us at HIP is not just about raising awareness of the impact of a brain injury. It also a reminder of the incredible journey of recovery, resilience, adaptation, and strength of HIP members along with the many others who grapple with the aftermath of brain injury.



A big shout out to all HIP members for the support, community, and sense of belonging you foster and the special things each member brings. It would be lovely if those who felt they wanted to share their own special life stories can do this together with us.
